Recent fundraising initiatives:

Thanks again for all the support which helped make our Christmas Fayre a huge success. The total amount raised was £6,640. This will cover the cost of the upper playground laser markings, which we hope to finalise, with the help of the children, in the next couple of months.

The children enjoyed lots of pizza, breadsticks and a sweet treat bag each. Thank you to all the parents who helped set up, supervise and clear up. A big thank you to Debbie Berkowitz who added some arts and crafts to the mix. The children loved the lego and bracelet making. The total amount raised was £1785 and this will be used to purchase new musical instruments for the school.

Ongoing fundraising initiatives:

The school hall is in need of an overhaul and the FHWS are keen to help raise funds for the redecoration of the hall and the replacement of the production lighting. We are hoping to replace the old curtains soon, with new blinds, which are vital, especially in the summer months. We also have an exciting ongoing project to rebuild the music room which is currently not being used. We would love to replace this with a two storey brick building, with separate access from the school to be used for after school clubs, bringing in a new income year after year. We hope to see this project begin very soon.
