To add more breadth and depth to our children’s curriculum and bring learning to life outside of the classroom, we have arranged a series of trips and workshops for your child to enjoy across the course of the academic year.

What is Enrichment?

Education is more than just mastering English and mathematics – it is also about activities that extend children's learning through new experiences and opportunities. Enrichment opportunities help provide children with a rounded, culturally rich education through activities which enhance their learning and provide them with the opportunity to try new things and develop new skills.

Enrichment at Hadley Wood

Our curriculum extends beyond the National Curriculum and includes a wide range of enriching experiences and opportunities both within and beyond the school day. This includes an extensive programme of after-school clubs, that support the core curriculum offer, as well as those which develop specialist skills, such as Spanish and French, coding and art whilst also extending the range of children’s experiences (Cultural Capital). A primary focus of our curriculum is to raise aspirations, engender a sense of personal pride in achievement, and provide a purpose and relevance for learning.
